The event will be held at **John Harrigan School P.S. 29**, **425 Henry Street (Btw. Baltic and Kane Streets) in Brooklyn, NY 11201** 

The Fee for the day is \$120 per space plus \$15 for optional table rental.

Since this is a public school event, please keep in mind that there will be children present so we would discourage any vendors who have fragile works such as glass sculptures. We also are sensitive about pricing, thus have a preference for \$20-\$150 items.

## Artist's Responsibility:

- Artist/artist's representative must be present at his/her display table during fair hours.
- Artist is responsible for the security of all items on display and any related equipment.
- Artist must provide all equipment necessary for his/her display.
- Artist may accept cash, check, or credit card payments for items sold. (No WIFI, use 3/4G)
- Artist must collect all sales tax on items sold.
- One 6' table (Note: PS 29 can provide for an additional fee. Please check if needed).

## PS 29 PTA will provide:

- Space for one 6' table (or similar) and folding chair for each artist to display work for sale
- Access to set up display at 10am on day of event. Breakdown at 4pm
- Marketing and PR, which will be distributed throughout Cobble Hill, Brooklyn Heights,
   DUMBO area as well as to families associated with our school.
